Stud fee of \$_____ shall be paid by the mare owner before the time the mare arrives for breeding or semen is shipped. A booking fee of \$150.00, which will be subtracted from the stud fee, will reserve a breeding. Mare care is additional, as specified by the breeding farm. The stallion owner agrees to allow free return privileges to the stallion by the same mare if the mare is examined by a licensed veterinarian by sonogram or by palpation and found to be barren, or if the mare comes back into heat on her next cycle. If, after a full breeding season, the mare fails to conceive, the stallion owner agrees to allow free return privileges to the stallion by the same mare or a substitute mare during the next breeding season for an additional booking fee (subject to change if breeding location changes). This is a one calendar year contract only. A breeding season is defined as March through September of a calendar year.

Mare owner must pay stud fee in full, or according to the payment schedule agreed on below.

Should the mare conceive but not produce a live foal that stands and nurses, the mare owner shall be entitled to free return privileges to the stallion by the same mare or a substitute mare during the same or the next breeding season, if the stallion owner is notified in writing by a licensed veterinarian. If the mare is to be re-bred as provided for

herein, and the Mare Owner fails to deliver her for breeding the following year, then any and all fees paid shall not be refundable and this contract is hereby cancelled.

In the event the mare does not conceive or does conceive and not produce a live foal that stands and nurses, and the stallion has died, been gelded, been sold, or has in any way become unfit for breeding, this contract becomes null and void and the mare owner shall be entitled to a refund of the stud fee in full.

In the event the mare does not conceive or does conceive and not produce a live foal that stands and nurses and the mare has been sold, this contract becomes null and void. Death of the mare after conception but before foaling will render this contract null and void.

The mare owner shall assume all responsibility for the condition of the mare, veterinary expenses for the mare and shall bear all risk of death or injury to the mare or escape of the mare during the breeding and boarding process and agrees to hold the stallion owner, breeding farm, and any person employed by or associated with the breeding farm blameless, not liable and not responsible for any and all damage to, injury to, or loss of the mare associated with boarding and breeding.

The stallion owner shall reserve the right to refuse any mare.

The mare owner will supply a clean uterine culture and cytology signed by a licensed veterinarian before the mare arrives for breeding or semen is shipped.

For fresh-shipped (cooled) semen: A down payment of \$200 towards shipping costs must be paid prior to each ship date, in addition to the stud fee. Should shipping costs exceed \$200, Mare Owner must pay the balance in a timely manner. Should shipping costs fall short of \$200, Mare Owner may either be refunded the difference or apply the difference to the next or future shipments.

For frozen shipped semen: A down payment of \$300 towards shipping costs must be paid prior to each ship date, in addition to the stud fee. Should shipping costs exceed \$300, Mare Owner must pay the balance in a timely manner. Should shipping costs fall short of \$300, Mare Owner may either be refunded the difference or apply the difference to the next or future shipments. Mare Owner and their veterinarian are responsible for properly handling, thawing, and use of frozen semen.

Mare Owner hereby understands that at least 24 hours advance notice must be provided to Stallion Owner for semen collection and shipment (this means 36 or more hours prior to the time that Mare Owner is able to inseminate said mare, for both fresh/cooled and frozen semen). Short-notice requests will always be accommodated if possible, but at the sole discretion of Stallion Owner.

Mare Owner understands that shipped semen may only be used for the mare identified in this contract. Should another mare be inseminated, another stud fee is due to the Stallion Owner.

This Agreement is binding, and shall not be assigned or transferred by either party hereto without the prior written consent of the other party.
